#### 1.- TRAINING OBJECTIVES

The 1st level Professional Master course and the Specialization course in Sacred Art aim to train experts in the sacred art field which is deeply rooted in the culture and tradition of our country and represents a big part of the Italian artistic heritage.

Each participant will be able to create and produce contemporary artworks related to the Christian tradition by the end of the course. Great attention is given to art and craft techniques (painting, sculpture, gold-smithing) which will be integrated with theoretical subjects and will make students able to interpret past and present sacred art, not only in aesthetic terms but also in its symbolic meaning and usage.

The 1st level Professional Master is taught in blended learning and consists of online and in-person sessions organized in 3 specializations:

- 1. painting,
- 2. sculpture,
- 3. goldsmithing.

The specialization course consists of the online theoretical part only.

#### 2.- RECIPIENTS AND ADMISSION

Enrollment for both courses is open to all bachelor's degree holders and is addressed to graduates in Architecture, Theology, Historical disciplines, Fine Arts, and Performing Arts in particular.

The course is also open to teachers of Art History, Religion, Philosophy, diocesan leaders, tour guides, and all those who wish to deepen theoretical, technical, and hand-craft aspects of sacred arts.

The minimum requirement for accessing the course is a Bachelors' Degree or equivalent title.

The minimum number of participants for the professional master course activation is 11.

The minimum number of participants for the specialization course activation is 20.

# **STUDENTS FROM NON-EU COUNTRIES**

Students from non-EU countries will have to submit their application form (within the deadline set every year by the MIUR at www.miur.it) to the Italian Embassies (or Consulates) of the country they live in. Therefore, in order to complete the enrolment process, it will be necessary to submit the declaration of the value of qualifications issued by recognized educational institutions, and a certified copy of the diplomas. These documents are issued by the Italian Embassies (or Consulates) of the students' countries of origin.

Applications received after the deadlines lacking the above-mentioned documents and not sent by official consular communication will not be accepted.

Enrolment "upon condition" is not admitted.





# 3.- EDUCATIONAL METHODOLOGY

The 1st level Professional Master Course is taught in Italian and English in blended learning and consists of:

- > online theory lessons (IUL training environment): 9 modules corresponding to 28 ECTS credits.
- >> An <u>in-class workshop</u>: a free choice workshop out of the three offered, for a total of 20 ECTS credits.
  - the theoretical part must be previously completed to access the practical part on one of the three specializations offered (painting, sculpture, and goldsmithing).
- > A final in-class examination for a total of 12ECTS credits.

The Specialization Course is an online course taught in Italian and English and consists of:

- >> online theory lessons (IUL training environment): 9 modules corresponding to 28 ECTS credits.
- > a <u>final in-class examination</u> for a total of 2 ECTS credits.

The in-class workshops will take place at Scuola di Arte Sacra in Viale della Catena, 4 Le Pavoniere - Parco delle Cascine - 50144 Firenze (FI), starting from **April 1, 2022 until June 30, 2022**. The student will be able to choose whether to remain at the School for the realization of the project to be presented at the final exam (November 2022) or work on it under the guidance of the Head of the chosen artistic discipline via distance learning.

Online modules are delivered in an e-learning environment characterized by the IUL training model which is flexible and custom-built on the students' previous knowledge and experience. It includes lectures and interactive teaching (forums, e-tivity, etc.) for each module.

Online teaching for each ECTS credit is structured as follows::

- ✓ 1 h lecture: audio or video recordings, web-conference lessons (online meetings, also referred to as "synchronous"), pre-structured courseware or similar (i.e. any material structured for educational purposes and offered in web environments of various types);
- ✓ 5 h of interactive teaching: didactic interventions by the teacher or tutor addressed to the class or part of it for additional demonstrations or explanations (FAQs, mailing lists, forums), brief interventions carried out by the students in forums, blogs and wikis, e-tivity (individual or collaborative) carried out by the students and feedback of it;
- √ 19 h of self-learning (individual and autonomous study).

This model includes assisted learning throughout the training, both by the teachers and the disciplinary tutors who are experts in the field, and a path tutor for transversal support.

Students must produce a work of art agreed upon with one of the teachers of the Master in one of the three specializations offered and present it in its content, materials, and techniques at the end of the training course.





All tests scheduled in each module must be completed to access the final exam.

The final exam will take place at IUL's Florence office, located in Via M. Buonarroti 10, 50122 Florence, or at the Sacred Art School in Viale della Catena, 4, Le Pavoniere – Parco delle Cascine – 50144 Florence.

The final grade will be based both on the dissertation and on the evaluation marks of the ongoing tests of each module.

# 4.- STUDY PLAN

The 1st level Professional Master Course (60 ECTS) is in blended mode and lasts one academic year for a total of 1,500 hours.

#### 5.- COURSE LENGTH

The <u>1st level Professional Master Course</u> lasts **one academic year** with a total amount of **1500 hours** corresponding to **60 ECTS**.

The Specialisation Course lasts one academic year with a total amount of 750 hours corresponding to 30 ECTS.

#### 6.- ENROLLMENT

The total cost of registration, attendance, final exam and awarding of the final certificate of the <u>1st level Master Course</u> is € 3,666.00 to be paid in 2 installments:

- 1. € 1.841,00 to be paid upon registration;
- 2. € 1.825,00 to be paid by April 29, 2022.

The total cost of registration, attendance, final exam and awarding of the final certificate of the <u>Specialisation</u> <u>Course</u> is € **1516,00** to be paid in 2 installments:

- 1. € 766,00 to be paid upon registration;
- 2. € 750,00 to be paid by April 30, 2022.

Teachers of schools of all levels, diocesan representatives, and professionals involved in the promotion and distribution of sacred art can enroll in the Specialization Course at the reduced cost of € 1,016.00 (one thousand sixteen/00) to be paid in two installments of € 516.00 and € 500.00 with the same deadlines.

Late payment of the second installment will involve an additional cost of € 30.00 for default fees.

The enrollment deadline is December 15, 2021.

Teaching activities are scheduled to start on January 10, 2022.

Registration to the course is made via the Gomp student portal (https://gomp.iuline.it/). Registration and payment procedures through the PagoPA system are described in detail in the Guide published on the institutional website together with this course description. Once the online application has been completed, it will be necessary to print it, sign it and send it – with a revenue stamp of 16.00 euros – to the postal address of "IUL online university", VIA M. BUONARROTI, 10 - 50122 FLORENCE", mandatory indicating in the payment purpose: "Registration – professional master course Sacred arts – student's name and surname".

Alternatively, it will be possible to send a copy of the scanned application form, duly signed and completed, exclusively from a nominal certified e-mail address to the following address: iul@pec.it

Foreign students not in possession of a certified e-mail address (PEC) must provide for the mailing of the printed application.

#### 7.- PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

The data provided will be processed under EU Regulation 2016/679 - General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The personal data provided will be collected and processed by the University, mainly by computerized means, to provide training services according to the institutional purposes of the University. The provision of such data is mandatory, and its partial or incorrect failure will make the interested party unable to enroll in the course. The data subject enjoys the rights outlined in Article 7 of the Personal Data Protection Code and Articles 15 to 22 of EU Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR), including the right to access personal data, to obtain their rectification or cancellation or the limitation of their processing, to request the portability of data, to oppose their processing, to revoke the consent, to complain to the supervisory authority (Privacy Guarantor). ### 8.- WITHDRAWAL POLICY

The student is granted the right to withdraw from participation in the Master's course and to request a refund of the paid amount only on a date before the official beginning of the teaching activities of the Master's course. This withdrawal may be exercised by sending a registered letter with return receipt to the IUL Secretariat (Via M. Buonarroti n. 10 - 50122 Firenze); in this case, the amount already paid for the first installment will be returned in full within 30 days from the receipt of the letter of withdrawal.

Once the teaching activities of the Master have officially started, the enrolled student will have to pay the entire registration fee.

Any waiver of the completion of the training course expressed beyond the above-mentioned terms will be ineffective and will not suspend the payments, therefore the student will be obliged to pay the entire fee regardless of the actual attendance of the training course.

# 9.- ACHIEVEMENT OF THE 1st LEVEL PROFESSIONAL MASTER COURSE

Participants will be awarded the First Level Master Diploma and a total of 60 ECTS at the end of the 1st Level Professional Master Course and after passing the final test.

The award of the 1st Level Professional Master Course in "Sacred Art" is subject to the following conditions:

- > regular attendance of e-learning and face-to-face training activities;
- > passing the scheduled online assessment exams/ongoing evaluations and the final in-class examination of each module;
- > discussion of the final dissertation in-class.





Participants will be awarded a Certificate of Attendance and a total of 30 ECTS at the end of the <u>Specialization</u> <u>Course</u> and after passing the final test.

The award of the Certificate is subject to the following conditions:

- > regular attendance of e-learning activities;
- > passing the scheduled online assessment exams/ongoing evaluations of each module.
- > Discussion of the final exam (Project Work) in-class.
